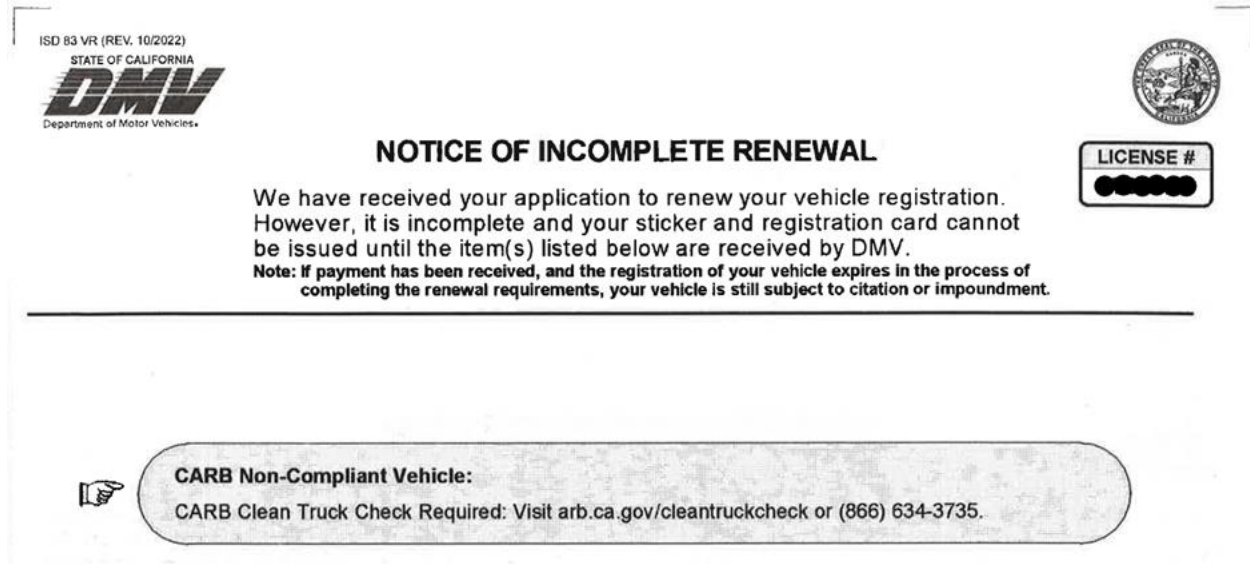


Have you received this notice from the DMV? An example is shown below. CARB is actively enforcing legislative mandates that require registration holds due to noncompliance with CARB regulations.



CA DMV registration holds are actively being placed on vehicles that do not comply with the Clean Truck Check requirements. To resolve or avoid California DMV registration holds, you will need to report vehicles and pay the annual compliance fee at [CTC-VIS](https://cleantruckcheck.arb.ca.gov/) (<https://cleantruckcheck.arb.ca.gov/>).

How to comply with Clean Truck Check Requirements

1. Report affected vehicles and pay the annual compliance fee.[†]
2. Prepare for emissions compliance testing. Emissions compliance testing requirements start in January 2025. Tests can be submitted up to 90 days before the testing deadline.^{††}
3. Subscribe to email notifications and select Clean Truck Check (Heavy Duty Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance) to receive emails about program updates.

[†] This is all that is needed to comply in 2024 and receive your tags.
